### Welcome

Since 1974, the American Suzuki Foundation has provided financial support to the Aber Suzuki Center by providing student scholarships, long and short term teacher trainee grants, research grants, training for faculty, and the purchase of instruments and equipment.

#### Statement of ASF purpose:

The American Suzuki Foundation exists to help support the students, families and activities of the Aber Suzuki Center.

#### Overview:

The American Suzuki Foundation Board oversees three funds, which are used to support the activities of the Foundation.

- Margery Aber Endowment Fund:** Since 1987, the Foundation has had stewardship of this fund, which has formed the basis of the Foundations awards.
- Kathleen Franceschi Fund:** Following the death of cellist Kathleen Franceschi, this fund was established specifically to support ASC cello students.
- Aber Childrens Scholarship Fund:** In 1994, Margery Aber established this fund to honor the memory of her parents, Earle and Vina Aber.
- Scholarship support:** Over the last several years, the Board has instituted several programs of support for ASC and its students.
- Margery W. Aber Scholarships:** The Foundation provides scholarship support for undergraduate and graduate music students at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, for those students studying to become Suzuki teachers.
- Needs-Based Scholarships:** Each semester, \$3,000 is granted in needs-based scholarships to the families of ASC students, in order to make lessons more affordable. Awards depend upon family income, the number of ASC students in the family and the level of involvement in the ASC program. Proceeds from the Kathleen Franceschi Fund are used to grant aid to cello students in the ASC program. Applications are accepted at the beginning of each new semester of instruction.
- Aber Childrens Scholarships:** Once each year, scholarships are awarded from the Aber Childrens Scholarship Fund. These awards are not based upon financial need, but rather on the applying

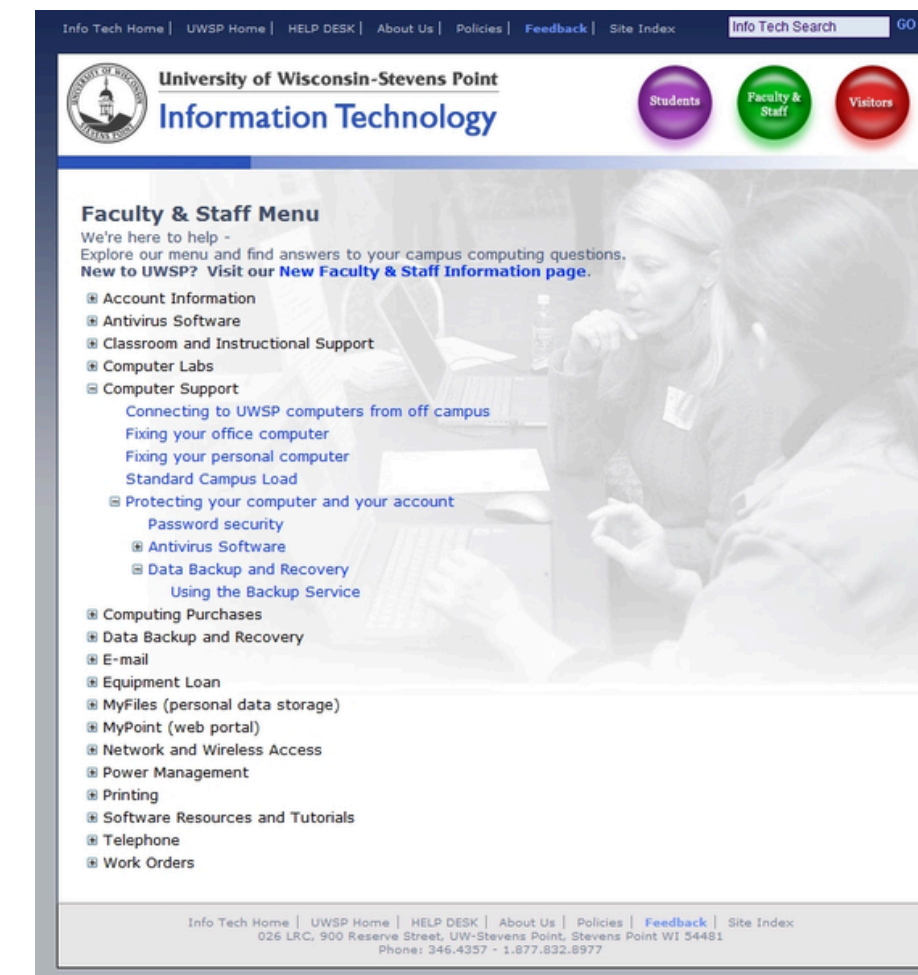
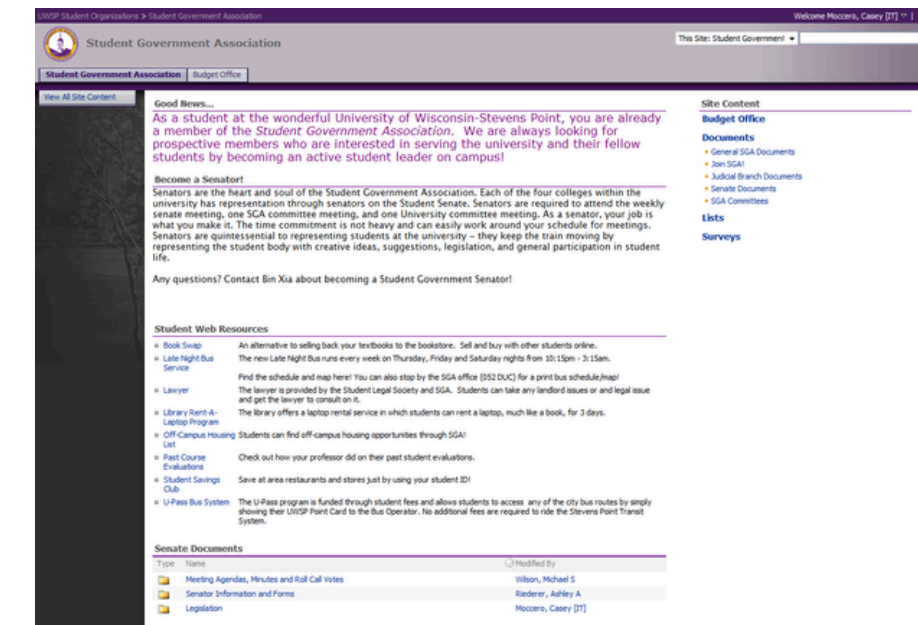
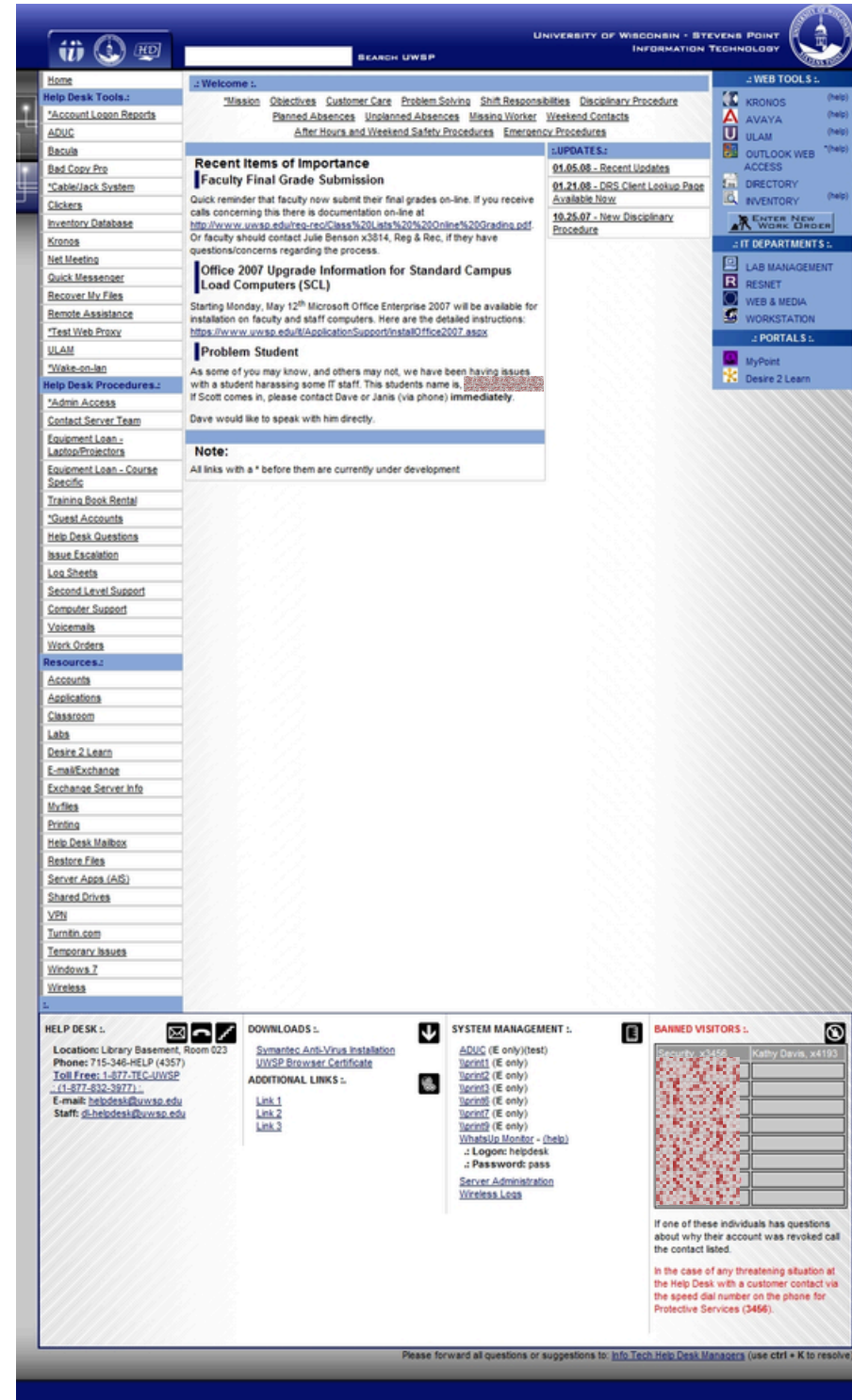

**Call for Papers**

Modeling & Simulation (M&S) is increasingly becoming a powerful tool in analyzing, designing, and engineering complex systems such as enterprise systems. The main focus of this workshop is on the role, importance, and application of Modeling and Simulation to Information Systems (IS), Enterprise Information Systems (EIS), Software Systems, and Business Systems in the context of Organization and Enterprise. The context of organization and enterprise implies that systems are designed to enable certain business processes, and to facilitate interaction of the actors, the system, and the environment. Thus, application of M&S to information systems involves the inclusion of social aspects and involvement of human actors too.

Traditionally, Modeling & Simulation have been endorsed as instruments to observe dynamic behavior of systems, measure IT impacts on organizations, and outcomes of changes. In the current context of open-source software development, service-oriented architectures (SOAs) and business process outsourcing (BPO), M&S assumes even more significance in assessing business process management effectiveness, alignment between business process models and corresponding SOAs, alignment between the client and vendor business strategies in a BPO contract, etc. using embedded simulation in enterprise and organizational models. In addition to extensive research programs, the field of M&S is actively attracting industry and tool developers. For businesses, the practice of M&S is becoming a de facto standard tool to measure, change and improve their business processes on regular basis.

In addition, there is a growing interest in this field from educational and curriculum perspective with programs at all levels including doctoral level (IS and MIS (management information systems) majors).
